Welcome to another exciting year with Destination ImagiNation® in Iowa. Please review the following instructions to register your team for the Iowa Destination ImagiNation® tournaments.

A registration fee of \$60.00 per competitive team (Elementary, Middle, Secondary Level, or University Level) and \$40 for each non-competitive team must accompany this registration form. Non-competitive teams include those elementary, middle, secondary, or university teams that choose to participate without being scored. Fees for all teams from a membership may be paid with one check or listed on the same Purchase Order.

Registration Deadline: **JANUARY 14, 2010**

Registrations postmarked after January 14, 2010 will have a registration fee of \$120 per competitive team and \$80 per primary or non-competitive team. Late registration deadline is January 22, 2010.

**Each team, that performs in projectOutreach® is responsible for providing an individual, who will be trained by Students for a Creative Iowa, to serve as a Challenge Appraiser at the Destination ImagiNation® tournaments in Iowa. A trained Challenge Appraiser is required to represent your team at the regional tournament in order for your team to participate at the state tournament.** A trained Challenge Appraiser who has appraised at the regional level is required to represent your team at the state tournament in order for your team to compete at the state level and advance to the Destination ImagiNation® Global Finals (if team qualifies). This ensures that all teams have an adequate number of well-trained Appraisers to watch, enjoy, and award points for team performances at each tournament.

## **IOWA Destination ImagiNation® 2010 APPRAISER CHALLENGE OVERVIEW**

### **Returning Appraisers who appraised in both 2008 and 2009:**

### **All other Appraisers (and returning Appraisers who are not pre-selecting):**

Please review the Challenges listed and come prepared to select your challenge at the training session. Please note, however, that at the time of your Challenge sign-up, not all Challenges may have open slots and you must be prepared with alternative selections and the possibility of being assigned to a Challenge based on Tournament need.

### **Challenge A – Direct Dposit (Technical)**

Sponsored by the Association of Equipment Manufacturers' Construction Challenge, Direct Dposit highlights skills needed for construction site delivery. Your team will:

- Present a team-created story about making a decision.
- Design and build a piece of equipment that delivers supply Objects over a Barrier to Targets.
- Consider risk versus reward to increase your Object score through strategic delivery to job site Targets.
- Create two Side Trips and integrate them into the Presentation.

### **Challenge B – DI®-BOT (Science/Theatrical)**

In DI-Bot, your team will study robotic technology and blend it into your performance! Your team will:

- Learn about Robotic Technology and the changes it brings about.
- Create an original Story that envisions and shows how at least one character's life may be changed by Robotic Technology.
- Design, create, and integrate a device called DI-BOT, which completes a motion or task, into the Story.
- Create a method to change at least one prop or set piece, or part(s) of the prop or set piece, into DI-BOT, or a part of DI-BOT.
- Create a scene change that enhances the Presentation by providing an effective transitional link from one scene to another.
- Create two Side Trips and integrate them into the Presentation.

### **Challenge C – You're Gonna Flip (Fine Arts)**

In You're Gonna Flip, your team will use theater, books and art as springboards for creating your own story about a serious change in perspective. Your team will:

- Present an Original Story dramatizing how a Character experiences a Flip, or a change of point of view, about someone or something.
- Design, construct, and feature at least one Puppet as a character in the Story.
- Create a piece of Live Visual Art that is to be completely produced during the Presentation.
- Create two Side Trips and integrate them into the Presentation.

### **Challenge D – Do or DI® (Improvitational)**

In Do or DI, your team will blend a Threatened Thing in danger of extinction, a Stock Character and an Unimpressive Superpower into an amazing, improvised story! Your team will:

- Create a five-minute Improvisational Skit about a Threatened Thing in danger of extinction. This must be done in a seven-minute Preparation Time period at the Tournament.
- Present a Skit using a Stock Character randomly selected from a list of stock characters that the team has previously researched.
- Incorporate props and/or scenery to enhance the Skit.
- Integrate a randomly selected Unimpressive Superpower that is revealed during the Skit.

### **Challenge E – Breaking DI® News (Structural)**

Sponsored by 3M, Breaking DI News will force your team to reduce your props, reuse a story and recycle newspapers to do more with less! Your team will:

- Design, build, and test a Structure made only of newsprint and glue.
- Reduce the props and scenery used in the Presentation to fit inside a 30in x 24in x 48in (76.20cm x 60.96cm x 121.92cm) container.
- Reuse a story about a Newsworthy Event in a nation other than your own.
- Recycle newsprint by using it creatively in a costume or prop.
- Create two Side Trips and integrate them into the Presentation.

### ***Instant Challenge: (Required for all teams)***

Instant Challenges require your team to engage in quick critical thinking. At a Tournament, your team will receive an Instant Challenge and the materials with which to solve it. You must think on their feet by applying appropriate skills to produce a solution in a period of just five to eight minutes. Instant Challenges provide an exciting, impromptu creative experience for your team!
